Some of its highlights are entertainment, history, beautiful gardens, wildlife, food, special events, sports, education, parks, recreation, as well as agriculture and bountiful farm country. All of these things set the stage for this upcoming art show: "Things I Love About DeKalb County".

specifications: Artwork must be original in any medium, 2D or 3D. No AI images or work from copy written material. Must be 18 years of age and older. Minimum painting size excluding mat, 108 square inches. Maximum size 48" x 48".

**FEE:** The non-refundable fee is \$25 for KVAL members and \$40 for non-members. Each fee allows you to submit up to two entries.

**SALES:** Exhibited works will be for sale at the price listed on your entry form. A 25% commission of artwork sold will go to KVAL Gallery on State. Works not for sale must be designated "NFS". KVAL is a non-profit organization and does not charge tax. Tax on sold items is the responsibility of the artist.

**FRAMING:** All frames must be wired for hanging. No sawtooth hangers are allowed. All other 2D and 3D works must be ready to install. Contact information and name must be on the back of each item.

**ENTRY SUBMISSIONS:** Images of work may be submitted by email or regular mail. Be sure to put your name, title of artwork and price on each submission.

**ACCEPTANCE:** Artists accepted will receive information pertinent to drop off, pick up and opening dates. Only accepted work is allowed for exhibition; no substitutions. Artwork sold may be picked up at the time of the sale. All other work will remain on exhibit for the duration of the show.

**PUBLICITY:** KVAL reserves the right to photograph all exhibited work for publicity purposes.

**DELIVERY & RETURN:** Accepted artwork should be hand delivered to KVAL Gallery on State on Sunday, September 28, from 12 to 4 pm and Monday September 29 from 2 - 6 pm. Pick up artwork on Sunday, November 2 from 12 - 4 pm and Monday, November 3 from 2 - 6 pm. KVAL will not be responsible for artwork not claimed 30 days after the last pick up date.
